 - a. In the 2016-17 total assets were \$57,424.44. Total assets for 17-18 is down about \$5000, but Tom doesn't believe that is cause for concern. The drop is due to a membership at the UW Union and a deposit for hosting our 2018 convention here. Normally this would go in

the following year, so essentially, we came out even even with the low turnout for last year's convention.
